## Mike's Musings

Nathan asked me to write the front-page article in this month's Tidal Wave. I have three things that I wanted to report.

First, I wanted to give the congregation an update on where your church is financially through the first three months of 2023. As of March 31<sup>st</sup>, FCCB reflected a \$33,000 net loss for the year. Giving for the year is \$30,000 behind the budget that the congregation approved in December and \$33,000 behind the same time as last year. Expenses were over the budgeted amount for the end of March by \$6,000, but we pay our insurance quarterly. Our March payment also covers \$4,330 for April and May, so we are actually under budget on expenses through March. The church still has \$100,000 in reserves, so we are not in any kind of financial difficulty. The trustees would like to keep the reserves in place in case we have an emergency. FCCB is a generous church, and we appreciate your continued generosity. If you have questions about the financial condition of the church or about tithing, I would be happy to meet with you. Just email me at [mike.amos@fc2b.org](mailto:mike.amos@fc2b.org) and we can set up a time.

Next, we are switching giving platforms. Pushpay is a great giving platform, but it does a lot of things that we don't really need or use. We pay for all the services with Pushpay whether we use them or not. **If you give using cash or check, you are not affected by this change at all.** We are moving to the Nucleus giving platform. This platform has all of the service that we need and should save us over \$4,000 a year. You can access our new giving platform at our website <https://fc2b.org>. If you go to giving tab, you will be using the new giving platform, and it is live now. If you use the recurring giving on Pushpay, you will have to log in and stop that feature. You can set up recurring giving on Nucleus and the process is very simple. We are working on the new QRL codes. If you have any questions, concerns or need help switching your recurring giving to Nucleus, please contact me and I will walk you through it.

Finally, we have a picture member directory. We have uploaded all of the pictures that we received to the directory. If you are not in the directory, it is due to one or two reasons. Either we don't have your picture, or you aren't a member of the church. Both items are easily corrected. If we don't have your picture, you can email a photo (preferable in a jpeg format) to [office@fc2b.org](mailto:office@fc2b.org). If you aren't a member, just join the church during the song of response or the invitation (depending on the service that you attend). Just come up and tell Nathan that you would like to join the church. If you would like a copy, email the office and we will email you a pdf version of the most current directory. If you want a paper copy, we are going to charge you \$5.00 to print it as it will probably change shortly as we get a new picture all the time.

This is a lot of information for you! I am always available if you have questions or concerns. Be Blessed! Pastor Mike

# Elder's Corner

## THE GODLY MOTHER

*Proverbs 31:26 She opens her mouth with wisdom, and on her tongue is the law of kindness.*

I chose to write the Elders Corner article for the month of May because it is the month of Mother's Day. I know first-hand the importance of a Godly mother and how a mother's influence can affect a child. While God made each mother unique in her own way, Godly mothers all have common threads that identify them as a Godly mother. A Godly mother obeys God and shows her children how to keep on the path of obedience and blessings, so that, as they grow to maturity, they will use God's Word in all situations they might face in life.

As a child, I remember my mother as a source of comfort, security, and support. I was confident in knowing she was always in my corner, no matter what. Until that day, everything changed. She and my dad could not accept their daughter in an interracial marriage. So, for a number of years, I was, in their words, "Dead to them." What a blow to my self-esteem. I was hurt to the very essence of my being. If my own mother didn't love me, how could anyone else? The Bible told me to honor my mother and my father; what kind of person could I be that they wouldn't want me? It took many years for my mother and I to make peace with these differences, but eventually, with God's help, we did, and both my parents came to accept my marriage and actually love my husband.

As a child growing up, I saw my mother reading her Bible each day, and watching Rev. Cecil Hodges at First Baptist Church of Savannah on TV every Sunday morning. But, because she hardly went to church (she never learned to drive, and my dad wasn't a church goer), I guess I never thought of her as a Godly mother.

It wasn't until the time in my life I felt most desperate, I realized it was her faith in God, and the faith instilled in me by her, and other godly women God put in my path that got us through to the other side. My mother's faith was very simple; nothing was impossible with God's help and all the answers to life's questions were in God's Word.

My mother passed away almost twenty-five years ago. Memories often come to mind of waking on Sunday mornings to the sound of gospel quartets whose names I've long forgotten and the smell of pot roast cooking in the oven, being grounded in knowing God loved me, and feeling rich even though we had very little. Our differences from years past, not so important anymore. Though a little flawed, as we all are, she was a godly mother.

If you take nothing away from this article today but one thing, let it be this. There is nothing like the power of a mother's love, no matter the age of the child. If you are privileged enough that God gives you the gift of motherhood, treasure that child and let them know your love is unconditional and more importantly, so is God's love for them.

The greatest accomplishment a mother could hope to achieve in this lifetime would be to have her children look back and reflect fondly on their memories of her and say, "Thank you, God, for my Godly mother. Help me continue to be a Godly parent to MY children." What a legacy to carry on! Happy Mother's Day to Mothers everywhere.

But beyond this, she deserves to be treated with kindness and respect at this very difficult time. They offer a wide range of support services and educational resources at no cost to clients in a professional, timely, and confidential manner. They have five centers in Jacksonville (West Beaches/Kernan, Mandarin, Clay County/Telehealth, Baker County, Northside) and a Mobile Center.

First Christian Church is one of FCWS's financial and prayer partners. Every month we send a financial contribution to FCWS from our Mission Team funds. Many of our women are Prayer Partners of FCWS, receiving text messages concerning prayer needs of their clients. (Client confidentiality is kept by using two initials that are not the client's own.) # Stewardship

While the Bible has about 500 verses on prayer and fewer than 500 verses on faith, there are over 2,300 biblical verses that deal with money and possessions. Without apology, our Lord said more about money than He did about any other subject, including heaven and hell put together. Over 10 percent of the New Testament relates directly to financial matters. Why is there such an emphasis?

One reason is that God knew we would have trouble managing our money, and that we would spend a great amount of time earning, spending, and investing it.

A second reason is that money has a profound effect on interpersonal relationships. Many people spend more than half their time thinking about money, and financial difficulties are a major cause of marital conflict and divorce.

A third reason is that the way we use our money is a real measure of our commitment to Christ.

Scripture relates money to the love of God: *"But whoever has the world's goods, and beholds his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him?" (1 John 3:17).*

We can assume an appearance of spirituality in prayer, Christian service, and Bible knowledge, but we cannot fake the way we use our money and possessions. Our wallet reveals more about our character and walk with the Lord than we may think.

## New Women's Christian Book Study




